

Fractions: Multiplication of Mixed Fractions

Multiply the fractions.

$$\text{Example: } 2\frac{3}{5} \times 1\frac{1}{5} = (2 \times 1) \frac{3 \times 1}{5 \times 5} = 2\frac{3}{25}$$
