## **Bees and pollination**

Put the pollination steps in order.

Pollen is a powdery substance that plants produce. Plants need to receive pollen from another plant before they can make seeds.



- Pollen from the flower sticks to the bees leg.
- \_\_\_\_\_ A bee lands on a flower.
- Pollen from the bees leg falls onto the 2nd flower.
- \_\_\_\_\_ The bee lands on a 2nd flower.
