Pos: He had been working on the project since morning.

Neg: He had not been working on the project since morning.

3) Had she been practicing the piano for hours?

Pos: She had been practicing the piano for hours.

Neg: She had not been practicing the piano for hours.

4) Had we been traveling for days before reaching our destination?

Pos: We had been traveling for days before reaching our destination.

Neg: We had not been traveling for days before reaching our destination.

Had they been playing basketball for two hours before the game was canceled?

Pos: They had been playing basketball for two hours before the game was canceled.

Neg: They had not been playing basketball for two hours before the game was canceled.
