Neg: They don't speak English fluently.

2) He brushes his hair before school.

Neg: He doesn't brush his hair before school.

3) We enjoy going to the movies.

Neg: We don't enjoy going to the movies.

4) The sun sets in the west.

Neg: The sun doesn't set in the west.

5) I play video games with friends.

Neg: I don't play video games with friends.

6) She dances at the ballet.

Neg: She doesn't dance at the ballet.

7) They eat pizza for lunch.

Neg: They don't eat pizza for lunch.

8) He wakes up early in the morning.

Neg: He doesn't wake up early in the morning.

9) We visit the museum on weekends.

Neg: We don't visit the museum on weekends.

10) The cat purrs when petted.

Neg: The cat doesn't purr when petted.
