



Present Perfect Continuous Tense **Write Interrogative Sentences (Key)**

1) The students have not been studying for the test all day.

Pos: *Have the students been studying for the test all day?*

2) You have not been working on the project all day.

Pos: *Have you been working on the project all day?*

3) He has not been playing the piano for three hours.

Pos: *Has he been playing the piano for three hours?*

4) She has not been painting since morning.

Pos: *Has she been painting since morning?*

5) They have not been practicing their lines for weeks.

Pos: *Have they been practicing their lines for weeks?*

6) It has not been raining heavily all afternoon.

Pos: *Has it been raining heavily all afternoon?*

7) John has not been studying for the exam since morning.

Pos: *Has John been studying for the exam since morning?*

8) Sarah has not been cooking dinner for the family for hours.

Pos: *Has Sarah been cooking dinner for the family for hours?*

9) The workers have not been building the house for months.

Pos: *Have the workers been building the house for months?*

10) I have not been reading a book for the past hour.

Pos: *Have I been reading a book for the past hour?*
