Neg: I had not been studying English for three hours.

2) He had been playing the guitar for two hours.

Neg: He had not been playing the guitar for two hours.

4) We had been waiting for the train for half an hour.

Neg: We had not been waiting for the train for half an hour.

Neg: It had not been raining heavily all afternoon.

7) John had been studying for the exam since morning.

Neg: John had not been studying for the exam since morning.

Neg: The workers had not been building the house for months before it was completed.

9) He had been playing the piano for three hours.

Neg: He had not been playing the piano for three hours.

10) She had been painting since morning.

Neg: She had not been painting since morning.
