5) They had been practicing their dance routine for weeks.

Que: Had they been practicing their dance routine for weeks?

6) It had been raining heavily all afternoon.

Que: Had it been raining heavily all afternoon?

7) John had been studying for the exam since morning.

Que: Had John been studying for the exam since morning?

8) The workers had been building the house for months before it was completed.

Que: Had the workers been building the house for months before it was completed?

9) He had been playing the piano for three hours.

Que: Had he been playing the piano for three hours?

10) She had been painting since morning.

Que: Had she been painting since morning?
