

Exercise -Past Perfect Tense (Key)

1) They had already eaten dinner when we arrived.

Neg: They had not already eaten dinner when we arrived.

Que: Had they already eaten dinner when we arrived?

2) It had stopped raining before we went out.

Neg: It had not stopped raining before we went out.

Que: Had it stopped raining before we went out?

3) John had studied for the exam before he took it.

Neg: John had not studied for the exam before he took it.

Que: Had John studied for the exam before he took it?

4) Sarah had finished her book before starting a new one.

Neg: Sarah had not finished her book before starting a new one.

Que: Had Sarah finished her book before starting a new one?

5) The train had departed before we reached the station.

Neg: The train had not departed before we reached the station.

Que: Had the train departed before we reached the station?
