

Exercise -Past Perfect Tense (Key)

1) Had they already eaten dinner when we arrived?

Pos: They had already eaten dinner when we arrived.

Neg: They had not already eaten dinner when we arrived.

2) Had it stopped raining before we went out?

Pos: It had stopped raining before we went out.

Neg: It had not stopped raining before we went out.

3) Had John studied for the exam before he took it?

Pos: John had studied for the exam before he took it.

Neg: John had not studied for the exam before he took it.

4) Had Sarah finished her book before starting a new one?

Pos: Sarah had finished her book before starting a new one.

Neg: Sarah had not finished her book before starting a new one.

5) Had the train departed before we reached the station?

Pos: The train had departed before we reached the station.

Neg: The train had not departed before we reached the station.
