

<u>Exercise -Present Perfect Continuous Tense</u> (<u>Key</u>)

1) The children have been playing outside all afternoon.

Neg: The children have not been playing outside all afternoon.

Que: Have the children been playing outside all afternoon?

2) I have been writing a novel for the past year.

Neg: I have not been writing a novel for the past year.

Que: Have I been writing a novel for the past year?

3) You have been working late every night this week.

Neg: You have not been working late every night this week.

Que: Have you been working late every night this week?

4) He has been practicing his basketball skills for hours.

Neg: He has not been practicing his basketball skills for hours.

Que: Has he been practicing his basketball skills for hours?

5) She has been studying for her exams all day.

Neg: She has not been studying for her exams all day.

Que: Has she been studying for her exams all day?
