2) We had not been living in the city for a decade before we moved to the countryside.

Pos: We had been living in the city for a decade before we moved to the countryside.

Que: Had we been living in the city for a decade before we moved to the countryside?

3) They had not been practicing their musical instruments for hours every day.

Pos: They had been practicing their musical instruments for hours every day.

Que: Had they been practicing their musical instruments for hours every day?

4) It had not been raining heavily since yesterday evening.

Pos: It had been raining heavily since yesterday evening.

Que: Had it been raining heavily since yesterday evening?

5) John had not been working on his novel for months before he finally completed it.

Pos: John had been working on his novel for months before he finally completed it.

Que: Had John been working on his novel for months before he finally completed it?
