**1)** Had John been studying English for months before he moved to an English-speaking country?

**Pos:** John had been studying English for months before he moved to an English-speaking country.

---

**Neg:** John had not been studying English for months before he moved to an English-speaking country.

---

**2)** Had Sarah been working out at the gym for an hour?

**Pos:** Sarah had been working out at the gym for an hour.

---

**Neg:** Sarah had not been working out at the gym for an hour.

---

**3)** Had I been studying English for three months?

**Pos:** I had been studying English for three months.

---

**Neg:** I had not been studying English for three months.

---

**4)** Had you been working on the project all day?

**Pos:** You had been working on the project all day.

---

**Neg:** You had not been working on the project all day.

---

**5)** Had he been playing the guitar for two hours?

**Pos:** He had been playing the guitar for two hours.

---

**Neg:** He had not been playing the guitar for two hours.
