

Exercise -Future Perfect Continuous Tense (Key)

Had John been studying English for months before he moved to an English-speaking country?

Pos: John had been studying English for months before he moved to an English-

speaking country.

Neg: John had not been studying English for months before he moved to an English-speaking country.

2) Had Sarah been working out at the gym for an hour?

Pos: Sarah had been working out at the gym for an hour.

Neg: Sarah had not been working out at the gym for an hour.

3) Had I been studying English for three months?

Pos: I had been studying English for three months.

Neg: I had not been studying English for three months.

4) Had you been working on the project all day?

Pos: You had been working on the project all day.

Neg: You had not been working on the project all day.

5) Had he been playing the guitar for two hours?

Pos: He had been playing the guitar for two hours.

Neq: He had not been playing the guitar for two hours.
