Pos: I had eaten breakfast before I left for work.

Neg: I had not eaten breakfast before I left for work.

2) Had you finished your homework before the deadline?

Pos: You had finished your homework before the deadline.

Neg: You had not finished your homework before the deadline.

3) Had he traveled to Paris before he moved to London?

Pos: He had traveled to Paris before he moved to London.

Neg: He had not traveled to Paris before he moved to London.

4) Had she studied for the exam before she took it?

Pos: She had studied for the exam before she took it.

Neg: She had not studied for the exam before she took it.

5) Had we visited the museum before it closed?

Pos: We had visited the museum before it closed.

Neg: We had not visited the museum before it closed.
