- 51)** **Pos.** John had been studying English for months before he moved to an English-speaking country.  
**Neg.** John had not been studying English for months before he moved to an English-speaking country.  
**Que.** Had John been studying English for months before he moved to an English-speaking country?

- 52)** **Pos.** Sarah had been working out at the gym for an hour.  
**Neg.** Sarah had not been working out at the gym for an hour.  
**Que.** Had Sarah been working out at the gym for an hour?
- 

- 53)** **Pos.** I had been studying English for three months.  
**Neg.** I had not been studying English for three months.  
**Que.** Had I been studying English for three months?
- 

- 54)** **Pos.** You had been working on the project all day.  
**Neg.** You had not been working on the project all day.  
**Que.** Had you been working on the project all day?
- 

- 55)** **Pos.** He had been playing the guitar for two hours.  
**Neg.** He had not been playing the guitar for two hours.  
**Que.** Had he been playing the guitar for two hours?
