

<u>Exercise -Present Perfect Continuous Tense</u> (<u>Key</u>)

1) We have not been exploring new hiking trails lately.

Pos: We have been exploring new hiking trails lately.

Que: Have we been exploring new hiking trails lately?

2) They have not been discussing the project for hours.

Pos: They have been discussing the project for hours.

Que: Have they been discussing the project for hours?

3) It has not been raining since this morning.

Pos: It has been raining since this morning.

Que: Has it been raining since this morning?

4) Mary has not been learning to play the piano for years.

Pos: Mary has been learning to play the piano for years.

Que: Has Mary been learning to play the piano for years?

5) Tom has not been working on his car all day.

Pos: Tom has been working on his car all day.

Que: Has Tom been working on his car all day?
