

Exercise -Present Perfect Continuous Tense (Key)

1) We have been exploring new hiking trails lately.

Neg: We have not been exploring new hiking trails lately.

Que: Have we been exploring new hiking trails lately?

2) They have been discussing the project for hours.

Neg: They have not been discussing the project for hours.

Que: Have they been discussing the project for hours?

3) It has been raining since this morning.

Neg: It has not been raining since this morning.

Que: Has it been raining since this morning?

4) Mary has been learning to play the piano for years.

Neg: Mary has not been learning to play the piano for years.

Que: Has Mary been learning to play the piano for years?

5) Tom has been working on his car all day.

Neg: Tom has not been working on his car all day.

Que: Has Tom been working on his car all day?
