Neg: The train doesn't arrive at 9 AM.

4) The students study for exams.

Neg: The students don't study for exams.

5) I enjoy listening to music.

Neg: I don't enjoy listening to music.

6) You like chocolate ice cream.

Neg: You don't like chocolate ice cream.

7) She speaks English fluently.

Neg: She doesn't speak English fluently.

8) We go to the gym every morning.

Neg: We don't go to the gym every morning.

9) They play video games together.

Neg: They don't play video games together.

10) Birds build nests in trees.

Neg: Birds don't build nests in trees.
