1) It has been a wonderful experience.

Neg: It has not been a wonderful experience.

Que: Has it been a wonderful experience?

2) You have solved the puzzle.

Neg: You have not solved the puzzle.

Que: Have you solved the puzzle?

3) I have met interesting people.

Neg: I have not met interesting people.

Que: Have I met interesting people?

4) She has finished her workout.

Neg: She has not finished her workout.

Que: Has she finished her workout?

5) He has visited his family.

Neg: He has not visited his family.

Que: Has he visited his family?
