1) They had lived in New York before they moved to California.

Neg: They had not lived in New York before they moved to California.

Que: Had they lived in New York before they moved to California?

2) It had rained before we went outside.

Neg: It had not rained before we went outside.

Que: Had it rained before we went outside?

3) John had won the game before he injured his knee.

Neg: John had not won the game before he injured his knee.

Que: Had John won the game before he injured his knee?

4) Sarah had finished her project before the deadline.

Neg: Sarah had not finished her project before the deadline.

Que: Had Sarah finished her project before the deadline?

5) The train had arrived before we reached the station.

Neg: The train had not arrived before we reached the station.

Que: Had the train arrived before we reached the station?
