

Exercise -Past Perfect Tense (Key)

1) Had they lived in New York before they moved to California?

Pos: They had lived in New York before they moved to California.

Neg: They had not lived in New York before they moved to California.

2) Had it rained before we went outside?

Pos: It had rained before we went outside.

Neg: It had not rained before we went outside.

3) Had John won the game before he injured his knee?

Pos: John had won the game before he injured his knee.

Neg: John had not won the game before he injured his knee.

4) Had Sarah finished her project before the deadline?

Pos: Sarah had finished her project before the deadline.

Neg: Sarah had not finished her project before the deadline.

5) Had the train arrived before we reached the station?

Pos: The train had arrived before we reached the station.

Neg: The train had not arrived before we reached the station.
