4) It was not snowing lightly.

Pos: *Was it snowing lightly?*

5) The children were not laughing uncontrollably.

Pos: *Were the children laughing uncontrollably?*

6) She was not wearing a hat and sunglasses.

Pos: *Was she wearing a hat and sunglasses?*

7) The teacher was not giving a lecture.

Pos: *Was the teacher giving a lecture?*

8) It was not getting colder outside.

Pos: *Was it getting colder outside?*

9) We were not singing our favorite songs.

Pos: *Were we singing our favorite songs?*

10) They were not playing with their toys.

Pos: *Were they playing with their toys?*
