Neg. We have not been exploring new hiking trails lately.

Que. Have we been exploring new hiking trails lately?

57) Pos. They have been discussing the project for hours.

Neg. They have not been discussing the project for hours.

Que. Have they been discussing the project for hours?

58) Pos. It has been raining since this morning.

Neg. It has not been raining since this morning.

Que. Has it been raining since this morning?

59) Pos. Mary has been learning to play the piano for years.

Neg. Mary has not been learning to play the piano for years.

Que. Has Mary been learning to play the piano for years?

60) Pos. Tom has been working on his car all day.

Neg. Tom has not been working on his car all day.

Que. Has Tom been working on his car all day?
