**Neg.** She had not been writing her novel since morning.

- 57)** **Pos.** We had been waiting for the train for half an hour.  
**Neg.** We had not been waiting for the train for half an hour.  
**Que.** Had we been waiting for the train for half an hour?

- 58)** **Pos.** They had been practicing their dance routine for weeks.  
**Neg.** They had not been practicing their dance routine for weeks.  
**Que.** Had they been practicing their dance routine for weeks?

- 59)** **Pos.** It had been raining heavily all afternoon.  
**Neg.** It had not been raining heavily all afternoon.  
**Que.** Had it been raining heavily all afternoon?

- 60)** **Pos.** John had been studying for the exam since morning.  
**Neg.** John had not been studying for the exam since morning.  
**Que.** Had John been studying for the exam since morning?
