1) The students have been preparing for the presentation.

Neg: The students have not been preparing for the presentation.

Que: Have the students been preparing for the presentation?

2) We have been waiting for our food for a long time.

Neg: We have not been waiting for our food for a long time.

Que: Have we been waiting for our food for a long time?

3) I have been working on this project all week.

Neg: I have not been working on this project all week.

Que: Have I been working on this project all week?

4) You have been studying for the exam for hours.

Neg: You have not been studying for the exam for hours.

Que: Have you been studying for the exam for hours?

5) He has been playing football since this morning.

Neg: He has not been playing football since this morning.

Que: Has he been playing football since this morning?
