Pos: He had visited Paris twice before.

Neg: He had not visited Paris twice before.

3) Had she cooked dinner for the family?

Pos: She had cooked dinner for the family.

Neg: She had not cooked dinner for the family.

4) Had they finished their work before the deadline?

Pos: They had finished their work before the deadline.

Neg: They had not finished their work before the deadline.

5) Had it rained heavily the whole day?

Pos: It had rained heavily the whole day.

Neg: It had not rained heavily the whole day.
