Write Negative Sentences (Key)

Neg: *Mary was not reading a novel in the park.*

2) John was writing a letter to his friend.

Neg: *John was not writing a letter to his friend.*

3) The dog was wagging its tail happily.

Neg: *The dog was not wagging its tail happily.*

4) The baby was giggling with joy.

Neg: *The baby was not giggling with joy.*

5) The car was honking loudly.

Neg: *The car was not honking loudly.*

6) My friends were planning a surprise party.

Neg: *My friends were not planning a surprise party.*

7) The birds were chirping in the morning.

Neg: *The birds were not chirping in the morning.*

8) We were traveling to a tropical island.

Neg: *We were not traveling to a tropical island.*

9) You were painting a beautiful picture.

Neg: *You were not painting a beautiful picture.*

10) They were watching a thrilling movie.

Neg: *They were not watching a thrilling movie.*
