61) Pos. He had been playing video games since morning.

Neg. He had not been playing video games since morning.

Que. Had he been playing video games since morning?

62) Pos. She had been cooking dinner for the family all evening.

Neg. She had not been cooking dinner for the family all evening.

Que. Had she been cooking dinner for the family all evening?

We had been traveling for hours before we reached our destination.

Neg. We had not been traveling for hours before we reached our destination.

Que. Had we been traveling for hours before we reached our destination?

64) Pos. They had been working on the project for weeks.

Neg. They had not been working on the project for weeks.

Que. Had they been working on the project for weeks?

65) Pos. It had been snowing heavily all day.

Neg. It had not been snowing heavily all day.

Que. Had it been snowing heavily all day?
