Pos: They have been practicing their dance routine.

Que: Have they been practicing their dance routine?

4) It has not been raining since yesterday.

Pos: It has been raining since yesterday.

Que: Has it been raining since yesterday?

5) John has not been studying Spanish for months.

Pos: John has been studying Spanish for months.

Que: Has John been studying Spanish for months?
