1) She has been painting a picture all day.

Neg: She has not been painting a picture all day.

Que: Has she been painting a picture all day?

2) We have been waiting in line for hours.

Neg: We have not been waiting in line for hours.

Que: Have we been waiting in line for hours?

3) They have been practicing their dance routine.

Neg: They have not been practicing their dance routine.

Que: Have they been practicing their dance routine?

4) It has been raining since yesterday.

Neg: It has not been raining since yesterday.

Que: Has it been raining since yesterday?

5) John has been studying Spanish for months.

Neg: John has not been studying Spanish for months.

Que: Has John been studying Spanish for months?
