Neg: He doesn't drive a blue car.

2) It rains a lot in the rainy season.

Neg: It doesn't rain a lot in the rainy season.

3) We have dinner together every night.

Neg: We don't have dinner together every night.

4) They listen to music before bed.

Neg: They don't listen to music before bed.

5) The cat meows loudly.

Neg: The cat doesn't meow loudly.

6) I speak Spanish fluently.

Neg: I don't speak Spanish fluently.

7) You enjoy playing video games.

Neg: You don't enjoy playing video games.

8) She writes poems in her free time.

Neg: She doesn't write poems in her free time.

9) We go on vacation every summer.

Neg: We don't go on vacation every summer.

10) They watch movies at the theater.

Neg: They don't watch movies at the theater.
