Neg: They weren't playing hide-and-seek.

Que: Were they playing hide-and-seek?

2) I was cooking dinner.

Neg: I wasn't cooking dinner.

Que: Was I cooking dinner?

3) I was studying for my exam.

Neg: I was not studying for my exam.

Que: Was I studying for my exam?

4) You were playing basketball.

**Neg:** You were not playing basketball.

Que: Were you playing basketball?

5) He was reading a book.

**Neg:** He was not reading a book.

Que: Was he reading a book?
