1) Is he playing with his dog?

Neg: He is not playing with his dog.

2) Is she going for a run?

Neg: She is not going for a run.

3) Is it getting darker?

Neg: It is not getting darker.

4) Are we having dinner?

Neg: We are not having dinner.

5) Are they studying together?

Neg: They are not studying together.

6) Is Mary writing a letter?

Neg: Mary is not writing a letter.

7) Is John playing with his toys?

Neg: John is not playing with his toys.

8) Is the dog sleeping?

Neg: The dog is not sleeping.

9) Is the baby babbling?

Neg: The baby is not babbling.

10) Is the car idling?

Neg: The car is not idling.
