66) Pos. She has been painting a picture all day.

Neg. She has not been painting a picture all day.

Que. Has she been painting a picture all day?

67) Pos. We have been waiting in line for hours.

Neg. We have not been waiting in line for hours.

Que. Have we been waiting in line for hours?

68) Pos. They have been practicing their dance routine.

Neg. They have not been practicing their dance routine.

Que. Have they been practicing their dance routine?

69) Pos. It has been raining since yesterday.

Neg. It has not been raining since yesterday.

Que. Has it been raining since yesterday?

70) Pos. John has been studying Spanish for months.

Neg. John has not been studying Spanish for months.

Que. Has John been studying Spanish for months?
