Neg: The cat doesn't jump onto the table.

Que: Does the cat jump onto the table?

3) My parents go on vacation every year.

Neq: My parents don't go on vacation every year.

Que: Do my parents go on vacation every year?

4) We enjoy watching movies at home.

Neg: We don't enjoy watching movies at home.

Que: Do we enjoy watching movies at home?

5) You speak French fluently.

Neg: You don't speak French fluently.

Que: Do you speak French fluently?
