

<u>Exercise -Present Perfect Continuous Tense</u> (<u>Key</u>)

1) Sarah has not been working on her project all week.

Pos: Sarah has been working on her project all week.

Que: Has Sarah been working on her project all week?

2) The children have not been playing outside all day.

Pos: The children have been playing outside all day.

Que: Have the children been playing outside all day?

3) I have not been reading this book for hours.

Pos: I have been reading this book for hours.

Que: Have I been reading this book for hours?

4) He has not been studying for the test all day.

Pos: He has been studying for the test all day.

Que: Has he been studying for the test all day?

5) She has not been working on her computer for hours.

Pos: She has been working on her computer for hours.

Que: Has she been working on her computer for hours?
