1) Sarah has been working on her project all week.

Neg: Sarah has not been working on her project all week.

Que: Has Sarah been working on her project all week?

2) The children have been playing outside all day.

Neg: The children have not been playing outside all day.

Que: Have the children been playing outside all day?

3) I have been reading this book for hours.

Neg: I have not been reading this book for hours.

Que: Have I been reading this book for hours?

4) He has been studying for the test all day.

Neg: He has not been studying for the test all day.

Que: Has he been studying for the test all day?

5) She has been working on her computer for hours.

Neg: She has not been working on her computer for hours.

Que: Has she been working on her computer for hours?
