Neg: We have not been traveling for weeks.

Que: Have we been traveling for weeks?

2) They have been discussing the project all day.

Neg: They have not been discussing the project all day.

Que: Have they been discussing the project all day?

3) It has been snowing since morning.

Neg: It has not been snowing since morning.

Que: Has it been snowing since morning?

4) We have been waiting for the bus for a long time.

Neg: We have not been waiting for the bus for a long time.

Que: Have we been waiting for the bus for a long time?

5) I have been working on this project for the past week.

Neg: I have not been working on this project for the past week.

Que: Have I been working on this project for the past week?
