1) Will we have been waiting for the bus for an hour?

Pos: We will have been waiting for the bus for an hour.

Neg: We will not have been waiting for the bus for an hour.

2) Will they have been playing soccer since morning?

Pos: They will have been playing soccer since morning.

Neg: They will not have been playing soccer since morning.

3) Will it have been raining for days by the time we arrive?

Pos: It will have been raining for days by the time we arrive.

Neg: It will not have been raining for days by the time we arrive.

4) Will John have been working as a teacher for five years?

Pos: John will have been working as a teacher for five years.

Neg: John will not have been working as a teacher for five years.

5) Will Sarah have been studying abroad for six months?

Pos: Sarah will have been studying abroad for six months.

Neg: Sarah will not have been studying abroad for six months.
