Pos: Was the car driving down the highway?

8) My friends were not talking and laughing.

Pos: Were my friends talking and laughing?

9) The birds were not chirping in the garden.

Pos: Were the birds chirping in the garden?

Pos: Were we singing karaoke at the party?
