Neg: Mary was not reading a magazine.

5) John was writing an email.

Neg: John was not writing an email.

6) The dog was sleeping on the couch.

Neg: The dog was not sleeping on the couch.

7) The car was driving down the highway.

Neg: The car was not driving down the highway.

8) My friends were talking and laughing.

Neg: My friends were not talking and laughing.

9) The birds were chirping in the garden.

Neg: The birds were not chirping in the garden.

10) We were singing karaoke at the party.

Neg: We were not singing karaoke at the party.
