78) Pos. It has been snowing since morning.

Neg. It has not been snowing since morning.

Que. Has it been snowing since morning?

79) Pos. We have been waiting for the bus for a long time.

Neg. We have not been waiting for the bus for a long time.

Que. Have we been waiting for the bus for a long time?

80) Pos. I have been working on this project for the past week.

Neg. I have not been working on this project for the past

week.
