76) Pos. We will have been waiting for the bus for an hour.

Neg. We will not have been waiting for the bus for an hour.

Que. Will we have been waiting for the bus for an hour?

77) Pos. They will have been playing soccer since morning.

Neg. They will not have been playing soccer since morning.

Que. Will they have been playing soccer since morning?

78) Pos. It will have been raining for days by the time we arrive.

Neg. It will not have been raining for days by the time we arrive.

Que. Will it have been raining for days by the time we arrive?

79) Pos. John will have been working as a teacher for five years.

Neg. John will not have been working as a teacher for five years.

Que. Will John have been working as a teacher for five years?

80) Pos. Sarah will have been studying abroad for six months.

Neg. Sarah will not have been studying abroad for six

months.

Que. Will Sarah have been studying abroad for six months?
