

<u>Exercise -Present Perfect Continuous Tense</u> (<u>Key</u>)

1) You have not been studying English for hours.

Pos: You have been studying English for hours.

Que: Have you been studying English for hours?

2) He has not been playing video games all day.

Pos: He has been playing video games all day.

Que: Has he been playing video games all day?

3) She has not been practicing yoga since morning.

Pos: She has been practicing yoga since morning.

Que: Has she been practicing yoga since morning?

4) They have not been learning to play the guitar for weeks.

Pos: They have been learning to play the guitar for weeks.

Que: Have they been learning to play the guitar for weeks?

5) John has not been studying for the exam all week.

Pos: John has been studying for the exam all week.

Que: Has John been studying for the exam all week?
