1) Will the construction workers have been building the bridge for a year?

Pos: The construction workers will have been building the bridge for a year.

Neg: The construction workers will not have been building the bridge for a year.

2) Will I have been working on this project for three hours?

Pos: I will have been working on this project for three hours.

Neg: I will not have been working on this project for three hours.

3) Will you have been studying French for six months?

Pos: You will have been studying French for six months.

Neg: You will not have been studying French for six months.

4) Will he have been playing the guitar for two hours?

Pos: He will have been playing the guitar for two hours.

Neg: He will not have been playing the guitar for two hours.

5) Will she have been traveling around Europe for a year?

Pos: She will have been traveling around Europe for a year.

Neg: She will not have been traveling around Europe for a year.
