5) She was not wearing a yellow dress.

Pos: Was she wearing a yellow dress?

6) The teacher was not writing on the whiteboard.

Pos: Was the teacher writing on the whiteboard?

7) It was not getting brighter outside.

Pos: Was it getting brighter outside?

8) We were not having a barbecue in the backyard.

Pos: Were we having a barbecue in the backyard?

Pos: Were they playing basketball?

10) Mary was not studying in the library.

Pos: Was Mary studying in the library?
