82) Pos. He has been playing video games all day.

Neg. He has not been playing video games all day.

83) Pos. She has been practicing yoga since morning.

Neg. She has not been practicing yoga since morning.

Que. Has she been practicing yoga since morning?

84) Pos. They have been learning to play the guitar for weeks.

Neg. They have not been learning to play the guitar for

· weeks.

Que. Have they been learning to play the guitar for weeks?

85) Pos. John has been studying for the exam all week.

Neg. John has not been studying for the exam all week.

Que. Has John been studying for the exam all week?
