- 81)** **Pos.** The construction workers will have been building the bridge for a year.
Neg. The construction workers will not have been building the bridge for a year.
Que. Will the construction workers have been building the bridge for a year?

- 82)** **Pos.** I will have been working on this project for three hours.
Neg. I will not have been working on this project for three hours.
Que. Will I have been working on this project for three hours?

- 83)** **Pos.** You will have been studying French for six months.
Neg. You will not have been studying French for six months.
Que. Will you have been studying French for six months?

- 84)** **Pos.** He will have been playing the guitar for two hours.
Neg. He will not have been playing the guitar for two hours.
Que. Will he have been playing the guitar for two hours?

- 85)** **Pos.** She will have been traveling around Europe for a year.
Neg. She will not have been traveling around Europe for a year.
Que. Will she have been traveling around Europe for a year?
