1) Sarah has been working on her art project all day.

Neg: Sarah has not been working on her art project all day.

Que: Has Sarah been working on her art project all day?

2) The children have been playing outside for hours.

Neg: The children have not been playing outside for hours.

Que: Have the children been playing outside for hours?

3) He has been working on his car all day.

Neg: He has not been working on his car all day.

Que: Has he been working on his car all day?

4) She has been baking cookies since this morning.

Neg: She has not been baking cookies since this morning.

Que: Has she been baking cookies since this morning?

5) Tom has been working on his novel all weekend.

Neg: Tom has not been working on his novel all weekend.

Que: Has Tom been working on his novel all weekend?
