Pos: We will have been waiting in line for hours.

Neg: We will not have been waiting in line for hours.

2) Will they have been rehearsing for the play for weeks?

Pos: They will have been rehearsing for the play for weeks.

Neg: They will not have been rehearsing for the play for weeks.

3) Will it have been raining all day?

Pos: It will have been raining all day.

Neg: It will not have been raining all day.

4) Will John have been studying for the exam all night?

Pos: John will have been studying for the exam all night.

Neg: John will not have been studying for the exam all night.

5) Will Sarah have been working on her novel for months?

Pos: Sarah will have been working on her novel for months.

Neg: Sarah will not have been working on her novel for months.
